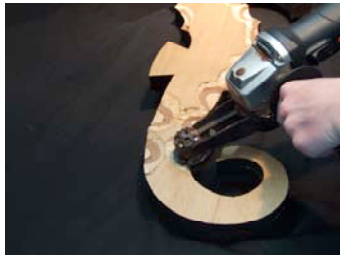




UNLEASH YOUR CREATIVITY

CARVED SEAHORSE

TOOLS REQUIRED: Mini Grinder, Plywood, Jigsaw, PVC wood glue, clamps



Step One Using the template attached, trace onto your sheet of plywood three copies of the seahorse stencil. Using a Jigsaw carefully cut out the seahorse shape. Glue and clamp all three sheets together using standard PVC wood glue. Leave to set overnight.

Step Two Using the Mini-grinder tool with the woodcarver blade attachment (MIN001) gently work outward in a stroking motion to create the seahorse's contoured shape. This is the first stage in removing the majority of the excess wood and will give you a layered plywood pattern.

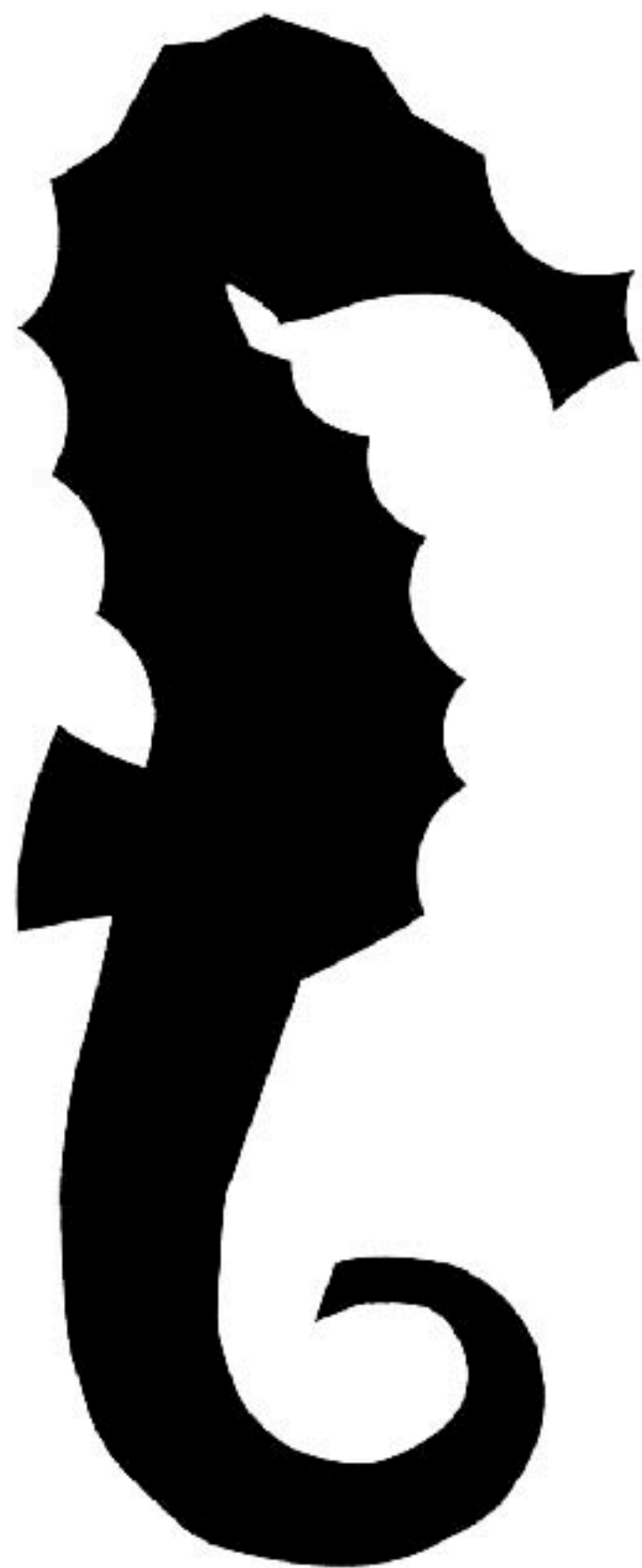
Step Three When you have completed shaping your seahorse fit the 50mm (2") Mini-Sanders (MIN006) attachment to your Mini-grinder. These come in assorted grits. To begin use the 40 grit disk to shape and smooth your seahorse.

Step Four

Move progressively to the finer grit disks, this will give your seahorse a finish that any qualified wood worker would be proud of.
